SELECTING THE CORRECT FLAG SIZE FOR A FLAGPOLE

For in-ground poles, the fly, or length of the flag should be at least one-quarter the height of the pole. For both safety and aesthetic reasons, the length should be no longer than one-third of the flagpole height. For example, a 20 foot pole should have at least a 5 foot length flag, so a 3'x5' flag would be appropriate.

Will you be selecting a flag for a house mounted pole or an in-ground pole?

As an FYI, burial flags (those placed on caskets for funerals) are an odd size of 9.5 feet by 5 feet.

Below are recommended size flags by pole size:
